The Longbrook Park Commission conducted the regularly scheduled meeting on Wednesday, February 28, 2007 in room 217 of Stratford Town Hall, 2725 Main Street, Stratford, CT pursuant to notice duly posted.

CALL TO ORDER: 7:02 p.m.

1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES — Minutes of January 24, 2007. A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. MCGUIRE SECONDED BY MR. FAHAN TO APPROVE THE FOREGOING MINUTES. THE MOTION PASSED 4 TO 0 WITH MR. SORRENTINO ABSENT.

2. MAINTENANCE ISSUES AND UPDATES

There has been no notice of any major vandalism except that the plastic liners from the trash cans have been tossed into the pond and an attempt was made to kick in the gate near the pool. There is no new information re: the birm.

When the police were notified re: drug vending from a pick-up truck, they did not respond.

3. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

The RFPs for dredging of lower pond and masonry work were written and will go out after Town Attorney's office proofreads them. Work is scheduled for these projects for middle of May.

It was pointed out that signs for park hours need to be posted. Town-wide Project Greensweep was discussed.

6. NEW BUSINESS — The following were discussed:


- Uniform benches and lighting for all park
